Teachers are made on teacher education institution. NCTE (National Council for Teacher Education) is the parent of Teacher Education institution. NCTE divided teacher education institutions of India into four regions (Eastern region, Western region, Northern region, Southern region). This paper study the duration of courses (B.Ed., M.Ed.), the number and percentage of teacher education institutions (B.Ed., M.Ed.) are present in eastern region state wise. B.Ed. and M.Ed. colleges present in West Bengal district wise, the details of colleges where M.Ed. courses occur in West Bengal.

NCTE established on 1971, NCTE act comes on 1993 and NCTE becomes autonomous from 1995. Now we come to the details of the courses.

## **B.Ed.** (Bachelor of Education):

This is a graduate professional course which prepares students for work as a teacher in schools, First starts in 1932 from Andhra University, Till 2014 duration of this course is 1 year in maximum universities, but after recommendation of Justice Verma Committee 2012, this course become 2 year duration.

### M.Ed. (Master of Education):

This course also professional course. First starts in 1934 from Bombay University. Till 2014 this course also duration of 1 year but from 2015 it becomes 2 years duration.

### COURSES AND DURATION OF B.Ed. & M.Ed.

There are so many courses are present in teacher education institutions, they are B.Ed., M.Ed., D.El.Ed., Integrated B.A. B.Ed./ B.Sc. B.Ed., B.Ed.(ODL Mode), Integrated B.Ed. M.Ed., B.P.Ed., M.P.Ed. Now we discuss about courses and duration of those courses in below.

In West Bengal maximum number of B.Ed. colleges is present in Murshidabad (104), North 24 Parganas (49), Bardhaman (48), Birbhum (47), and Paschim Medinipur (47) and minimum number of colleges is present in Cooch Bihar (8), Darjeeling (8), Purulia (12) and Jalpaiguri (14).

In the case of M.Ed. there are total 24 institutions present where M.Ed course occurs in West Bengal. Among them 4 are present in Kolkata, 3 present in each of in Howrah, Purba Mednipur, Bardhaman and North 24 Parganas. There are no M.Ed. colleges present in Hoogly, Bankura, Purulia, Malda, Uttar Dinajpur, Coch Bihar and Darjeeling.
